


# Becoming a learner at Transition 2



Our College motto is 'start with the end in sight' so it is really important that you know **why** you would like to come to Transition 2.



**Decisions** about places and funding may **take a while**, so you will need to begin the application process **early** in the academic year before the one in which you intend to start.



**Before applying** for a place at our College, we would like you and your parent(s) or carer(s) to **arrange a visit**, during which you will have a **tour** of our facilities and a chance to **share information** about your educational goals.



**After visiting**, if you are still interested in being a learner at Transition 2, you will need to submit an **application form**.



We will also need some **information** from your School/College, Social Worker and Personal Advisor to help us **decide** if we are the right people to support your continuing education.



If you are seeking a full-time place (3 days per week), our Teaching & Learning Coordinator and our Head of Service will **visit you** at your **current School/College** to learn more about your interests and goals.



If you are seeking a part-time place through a **personal budget**, our Teaching & Learning Coordinator and our Head of Service will liaise with your Social Worker and current/previous providers of education to learn more about your **learning journey** so far.



When we have all the **information** we need, we will make a **decision** about whether we can support your ongoing educational goals. If we feel we are the right place for you to continue your education, we will submit an assessment report to the **Local Authority** who will then decide if they can **fund** your place (full-time programmes only). For those young adults seeking places via a personal budget, we will liaise with your **Social Worker** about **funding** requirements.



If we cannot meet your needs we will **explain** why and offer **suggestions** about alternative provision.



If you are offered a place to **continue your learning**, we will discuss with you and your circle of support a plan to begin your **transition** to our College.
