



Transition2: Transition from Pre-Supported Internship (Pre-SI) to Supported Internship (SI) Position Statement 2025-2027

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The transition from the Pre-Supported Internship (Pre-SI) programme to the Supported Internship (SI) programme has been carefully considered to ensure learners are prepared for progression into the world of work. Although learners complete the Pre-SI programme in July, employer placements for Supported Internships commence from October, with some individual placements becoming fully established later in the academic year. This planned transition allows learners to develop the skills, confidence and readiness required for successful workplace experiences.

To maintain continuity of learning and minimise skills regression during the summer period, the college café remains operational throughout the holidays, supported by staff on 52-week contracts. Learners are invited to attend regularly to continue developing their vocational competencies, employability skills and work stamina in preparation for September. In addition, 52-week staff facilitate learner meet-ups at FGS, enabling learners to maintain engagement, social confidence and independence throughout the break.



Learners on both Pre-SI and SI return to Transition2 in September to prepare for employer placements, which begin from October. Learners already participating in Supported Internships continue to receive individualised support from job coaches throughout the summer, ensuring continuity in employment, sustained progress and positive outcomes.
